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Kumi by Akira Back

Location: Mandalay Bay, 3950 Las Vegas Blvd. S.

Opening: July

Replacing the shuttered China Grill at Mandalay Bay, Akira Back of Yellowtail at the Bellagio will front Kumi, a modern Japanese with a Korean twist.

Expect to find a 10,000-square-foot restaurant with room for 300. A dramatic sushi bar made of glazed cobalt blue tiles in a scalloped pattern inspired by common Japanese homes creates the setting for the restaurant, with a rear rotunda replete with walls painted with giant interpretations of cherry blossom trees.
