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Atrium Dumbo^o has bloomed in Brooklyn, where three **DB Bistro Moderne** alums—including beverage director Alexander LaPratt—are serving contemporary fare packed with of-the-moment ingredients (octopus, check; sweetbreads, check; kale, check) alongside a 100-bottle wine list and house-infused cocktails. Chicago's beer buffs are hitting the jackpot with the opening of **The Arrogant Frog**^o, with 24 taps devoted largely to local brewers; domestic craft whiskey is a secondary focus, and the kitchen will be up and running soon. **Hoxton**^o sibling **Boxpark**^o is now open in Miami to serve up modern, game-heavy Floridian fare. Bostonians, meanwhile, are bidding farewell to harborside institution **Anthony's Pier 4**.

West of the Mississippi, chef Akira Back (also of **Yellowtail**^o at the Bellagio) has launched the glittery **Kumi Japanese Restaurant + Bar**^o in Las Vegas' Mandalay Bay. Cajun meets Pacific-coastal cuisine at the breezily elegant **Big Sur Roadhouse**^o, where local seafood graces po' boys and gumbo replaces cioppino—though Italian influence shows itself in the wine list, which also features California pours. Italy's likewise the focus at **Bucato**^o in Culver City, where housemade pasta will star when the doors open in a few days.
